In the month ahead we have several events planned, please ensure you check these events from looking at the website and especially 'OurSchoolApp,' it is very rare we send text messages now regarding school events, as we have more powerful and cost effective ways of informing parents/carers of school matters, but you must assist us with this and ensure you regularly check these sites. If you do not have the App please speak to Mrs Raine. There are many December events dates added and more to add this week.

Our Year 6 pupils are in Ford Castle and from what we have heard they are having an action packed time, can't wait to hear all about their adventures on their return. If your child is currently in Year 5, we will soon be sending out information for their residential, when they are in Year 6.

Coming up we have our new whole school parents/carers 'drop in' evenings, more 'If U Care Share' coffee mornings, the Halloween disco and our spooky themed lunches week....to name a few.

After school clubs have been very well attended so far, just a reminder that the current clubs (not including band, art, cross country or karate) will end before we break up for the half term, but details of the next set of clubs will be circulated shortly.

Attendance Update

The whole school attendance for September was an amazing 97.07%, which is above the governments floor target of 96%.

If your child is absent from school for any reason you MUST inform the school. There were several children absent last week and no reason had been provided. There are several ways you can inform the school office, as it is known that sometimes getting through on busy mornings can be difficult. You can ring 01207 504431, you can text 07537436638 or you can email consettjunior@durhamlearning.net

If your child is poorly and their illness means they need to be absent for 48 hours, you do not need to ring on the second day of absence, however, if this goes into the third day then you must make contact with school. If your child's absences become frequent or pattern based, i.e. off regularly on Mondays or Fridays, then action will be taken to prove your child is off unwell. This may mean letters are requested from their GP, or a home visit from the school or attendance team officer. Further concern will result in a referral to the Local Authority, where warnings, interviews or fines are issued.

If you do not inform the office regarding absence, or we have reason to believe the reason provided for your child's absence is not correct, we will refer. There have been occasions where children have told us they have been on holiday, yet families claim they have been unwell.

It is against the law to keep your child off school if they are well enough to be in.

Please ensure you try to make medical appointments outside of school time, any made during the school day must be supported with a letter detailing the appointment. Although medical appointments are authorised, they do not qualify as an attendance mark.

September attendance overview

Class 8 achieved the highest % class attendance for September and their non-uniform day reward was Friday 4th October.

Year 6 achieved the highest attendance as a year group for September and they will each receive a giant cake/cookie on Friday 4th October. Well done.

If your child is in Year 6 and you would like to know how they are progressing so far in their academic year, the school will be open on Thursday 19th October from 3.30 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. (last person entry at 5.40 p.m.), for you to come in with your child to visit their classroom. NO APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED.

You can spend time looking at their work and the teachers will be available should you need to talk.

If you would like to speak with your child's class teacher, and feel this service is not an option for you. Please contact the school office to discuss other arrangements.

School Dinners

Please ensure you follow policy when changing meal arrangements for your child, we require 2 weeks notice, but this can sometimes be accommodated sooner if other children are also changing meal arrangements. If you do not inform the office your ParentPay account will be charged.

A note from our cook, Mr Maddison:

"This term we look forward to a very special "Spooky Week" of meals before the half term to celebrate Halloween. This is a themed week with lots of favourites with a ghoulish twist! The deadline to order lunches for this week is Friday 4th October. You do not need to order a lunch if your child is already on school meals. If your child is currently in Year 5, we are looking to book a residential for next September/October 2020. Once finalised more details will go home with your child and posted on our app and website.

Halloween Disco

We are holding an after school Halloween Disco on **Wednesday 23rd October**. Tickets are £3 each and go on sale on Monday 7th October. We will provide each child with a party bag to take home after the disco.

The disco starts at 3.30 p.m. and finishes at 5.00 p.m. Children will leave the school premises in the usual way (play yard), so please ensure your child knows where you will be waiting for them as it will be dark.

Children have several options for wearing Halloween costumes during the day:

- 1) Children can come to school in their uniform but bring their costumes to change into at 3.30 p.m.
- 2) Children can come to school wearing their Halloween costumes. If children have masks/hoods they must NOT wear these during the school day so that we can identify who the children are, which is very important at break times.
- 3) Children can come to school in their uniform and not stay for the disco
- 4) Children can come to school in their costume/uniform for £1 and not stay for the disco but will still be given a party bag as part of their £1 charge. You must specify this when paying your £1.

If children lose their ticket, they do not need to worry as Mrs Raine keeps a register of ticket sales.
