We have been using this App for almost three years now, it is a very good and efficient way of communicating with everyone, it is a very low cost to the school and free for families to download. The App and the school website are the main means of communication. Please download the App, I appreciate that daily 'news' and 'Calendar' notifications can be frustrating, but as we have previously informed you can disable these notifications (App-Settings-Notifications). Please remember, if you do disable notifications then it means you are responsible for opening the App to check for alerts on a daily basis.

February Attendance

The whole school attendance for February was an excellent 96.89% which is a slight drop from January but we are still above our floor target of 96%. Sickness absences are always going to impact, we have 218 pupils on roll therefore completely unavoidable. Unauthorised absences are still evident in all year groups, with year 6 being the highest. If daily reporting to school is in place in year 3, then by year 6 we should have little to none. Most parents/carers are very good at informing us of the reason for their child's absence, which can be done via calling, texting or emailing the school. All year groups are above the floor target!

As year 6 have once again achieved the best attendance for February each child in year 6 will be given a cake/giant cookie next Friday, 6th March as their reward.

Class 5 (Miss Breheny) have knocked Class 8 off the top spot and achieved the reward for the best class attendance at an outstanding 98.45%, well done! The Class 5 reward for this is a FREE non-uniform day which will also be next Friday. Mind, Class 8 were very close at 98.26!

The spring terms 100% attendance King's Café ice-cream and movie treat is on Thursday 2nd April (p.m.). This for all children who have achieved 100% attendance from the 7th January. If your child had not yet achieved this termly reward they still have the summer term to aim towards.

Special Person's Day Lunch for Mothers Day - Wednesday 18th March and Wednesday 25th March

If you have booked a place to have lunch with your child on this day you will have already received text confirmation. You will also receive a reminder text a few days prior to your allocated date. Please, please remember to let us know if you can no longer attend, there is a small waiting list, and your child will need to attend a different lunch sitting on that day. There is opportunity for you to go outdoors or pop into your child's classroom with your child straight after lunch, but for parents who need to get back to work, you can also leave straight after the meal. If you have not been allocated a place, please do not just turn up as we will not be able to accommodate you and your child will already have had their lunch.

You need to arrive at school for 12.15 p.m., if you arrive too early you will need to wait in reception/queue until the hall is open to you. Your child will be waiting for you in the hall (siblings will be grouped together). Some families still need to pay for their lunch, this is through ParentPay and the cost is £2.05 per child and £2.46 for the adult.

Sport Relief 2020 - Friday 20th March
