I hope all our families enjoyed the Easter holidays in whatever they did together, we now lead ourselves into the summer term and its already looking busy! Please take a moment to read this newsletter and make a note of dates applicable to your child.

Attendance

The attendance for March was quite impressive based on the number of cases of Scarlet Fever, overall, the attendance for the month was 96.06% which is above the government target of 96%. I passionately believe that this is because we all worked together to establish and treat cases of Scarlett Fever, including following the advice of the Health Protection Team. Thank you to all families for working with us to prevent and treat this illness as we could not have done this on our own.

Over the next two weeks we will be looking at all individual attendance's again (summer term review) and will need to invite several families into school for a meeting to discuss support and strategies to improve attendance. I am proud to say that most meetings held for children in the spring and autumn terms were positive and improvements have been noted, thank you to those families.

Some families may remember me reporting to on attendance regulations two years ago, the governments push was to make their 'working together to improve attendance' legislation rather than guidance. Two years on and this has now become mandatory (as of 18th August 2024) and with it there are changes that will affect all families.

Some of the key changes are:

- A fine to parents must be considered if a child misses 5 days of school for unauthorised absence, this is currently
 7 days.
- Absence fines charged to parents will rise from £60 to £80, or £160 if not paid within 21 days.
- From Autumn term 2024, only two fines can be issued to the same parent for the same child within a three-year rolling period. Any notice thereafter will automatically be charged at £160.
- From September, schools will have to consider a fine if a pupil misses 10 sessions (half days) of unauthorised absence in a rolling period of 10 school weeks. This includes 'late' absences after registers are closed ('U') codes
- We already do this, but all schools must share daily attendance data with government from September.

As you are all aware, we regularly promote and support families and children with attendance and educate the children about the importance of being in school regularly and on time, in March there were 68 'late' marks recorded, remember that children not in school before 9.15 a.m. are marked as 'unauthorised' (U) which means they arrived at school but too late, these 'U' codes count as sessions missed and will count in the process of issuing 'FPN's'. Our incentives are enjoyed by the children, on many occasions I have needed to promote our strategies with the LEA as they often do not

feel rewarding children is the way forward, but our monthly, termly, and annual rewards are welcomed. We currently have 34 children with 100% attendance for this entire school year, these children, if still at 100% will be taken out for a meal, by staff, at the end of the year. Last year only 13 children achieved this, so I am already negotiating booking the entire restaurant!

March attendance results...

What a close race this month, Year 6 have topped the charts with 97.3% attendance, therefore their treat day is Friday 19th April, children in Year 6 will have a selection of goodies to enjoy that day.

The registration group reward was remarkably close indeed; however, Class 5 DID IT AGAIN! They are phenomenal, they achieved 98.3% attendance in March and were closely followed by Class 7 who achieved 98.2%...well done again Class 5, enjoy a free non-uniform day on Friday 19th April.

School Dinners

As already informed, the daily cost for dinners has risen again and is now £2.81, this is sad news but out of our hands and due to the cost of food prices. On return to school after Easter children can also choose a 'school packed lunch' option. We are a pilot school for this school meal and their push is to try and help FSM families with children that bring in a packed lunch each day.

Parents, Carers and Childminders Drop-In (Send and inclusion team)

On Tuesday 16th April, from 1pm-3pm we are holding a Parents, Carers and Childminders Drop-In and Chat Coffee afternoon with Sabrina Basra and Theresa Eastaugh who are Advisory Inclusion Teachers from the SEND & INCLUSION team at Durham County Council. This will be an informal group chat where we can talk about challenges, difficulties, and solutions offering support and guidance and signposting to other agencies/professionals. No need to book - just turn up any time. We look forward to seeing you there!

Around the World in Sporty Ways- American Football

On Monday 15th April, which is the first day back after the holidays, we have a special sporting event happening in school.

On this day, we have an external coach with a sporting theme of 'Around the World' they have chosen to come in to teach all classes how to play American Football! Children can come to school on this day wearing their normal PE kits, or if they wish to, they could wear the colours of the American flag (red, white, and blue), they could come dressed as an American footballer or they might want to wear a football kit they already own.

Year 6 trip to Robinwood 2024 – Monday 20th – Wednesday 22nd May 2024

The deadline to pay in full is Friday 26th April to ensure your child can go. FAILURE TO PAY IN FULL ON THIS DATE WILL RESULT IN YOUR CHILD LOSING THEIR PLACE. Please log in and check your child's balance, there are still families that have only paid their

deposit, so it is imperative to check. If you do not pay in full by end of day on Friday 26th April then your deposit will be lost and all funds you did pay (if any) will be refunded back to your ParentPay account that day, we will also remove your child's details from the portal we share with Robinwood. When you completed the form to request a place last year you accepted the payment terms stated.

Year 6 trip to Robinwood 2025 – Monday 19th – Wednesday 21st May 2025

Deposits are due on or before 26th April and the final balance is to be paid by Friday 25th April 2025. If you do not pay your £25 deposit by 26th April then your child's place on ParentPay will be removed, therefore, removing their place from the trip in 2025.

<u>School uniform ordering – September 2024</u>

I know you might feel like it is too far away to think about or may even not want to believe we are nearing the end of a school year. But from my experience it is always worth a little reminder that it is best to be prepared and start thinking about ordering uniform for September sooner rather than later. July and August are remarkably busy months for all uniform providers, and I would not want you to leave it too late so that it does not arrive in time for September. Delivery can be made to home or school but if you are ordering for delivery to school, please <u>do not</u> choose this option if placing orders in July.

There is NO expectation that you purchase uniform from our providers, many high streets stores stock our colours of uniform. All we do expect is that children do wear our colours.
